

Programming the Single Channel Remote

Note: First, awning should be closed and motor unplugged (at least 10 seconds).

Step 1. Connect the motor power cord to wall/electrical outlet.

Step 2. Press the **P2** button twice on the back of the remote control. (listen for beep)

Step 3. Press and hold the **Down** button on the front of the remote control until the beeping stops. (listen for beep)

Programming is completed. To open the Drop Shade, simply push the **Down** button and to close simply push the **Up** button.



Programming the (5) Five Channel Remote

Note: First, all awnings should be closed and motor unplugged (at least 10 seconds).

Step 1. After selecting an awning, press the **P1+** button on the front of the remote control to scroll up (**P1-** to scroll down) and select a channel. A **Red** light will appear on the right side of the screen indicating the channel selection.

Step 2. On the selected awning, connect the motor power cord to wall/electrical outlet.

Step 3. Press the **P2** button twice on the back of the remote control. (listen for beep)

Step 4. Press and hold the **Down** button on the front of the remote control until the beeping stops. (listen for beep)

Step 5. Repeat Steps 1 thru 4 for each additional channel needed (up to five).

- To operate a single channel, simply scroll to the proper channel and push the **Up** or **Down** button.

- To operate all channels together simultaneously, scroll up or down until all the lights are **Red**.



Programming the (15) Fifteen Channel Remote

Note: First, all awnings should be closed and motor unplugged (at least 10 seconds).

Step 1. After selecting an awning, press the **P1+** button on the front of the remote control to scroll up (**P1-** to scroll down) and select a channel. A digital number will appear on the screen indicating the channel selection.

Step 2. On the selected awning, connect the motor power cord to wall/electrical outlet.

Step 3. Press the **P2** button twice on the back of the remote control. (listen for beep)

Step 4. Press and hold the **Down** button on the front of the remote control until the beeping stops. (listen for beep)

Step 5. Repeat Steps 1 thru 4 for each additional channel needed (up to fifteen).

- To operate a single channel, simply scroll to the proper channel and push the **Up** or **Down** button.

- To operate all the channels together simultaneously, simply scroll up or down until the digital number reads **00** then push the **Up** or **Down** button.
